

**Why?** Financial companies choose how they share your personal information. Federal law gives consumers the right to limit some but not all sharing. Federal law also requires us to tell you how we collect, share, and protect your personal information. Please read this notice carefully to understand what we do.

**What?** The types of personal information we collect and share depend on the product or service you have with us. This information can include:

- Social Security number and income
- Account balances, account activity and payment history
- Credit history and credit score

**How?** All financial companies need to share customer personal information to run their everyday business. In the section below, we list the reasons financial companies can share their customer’s personal information; the reasons The Nationwide Group of Companies chooses to share; and whether you can limit this sharing.

## What we do

<b>How does The Nationwide Group of Companies protect my personal information?</b>	To protect your personal information from unauthorized access and use, we use security measures that comply with federal law. These measures include computer safeguards and secured files and buildings.
<b>How does The Nationwide Group of Companies collect my personal information?</b>	<p>We collect your personal information, for example, when you:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ Open an account</li> <li>▪ Pay your bills with us</li> <li>▪ Provide employment information</li> <li>▪ Give us your contact information</li> <li>▪ Apply for a loan</li> </ul> <p>We also collect your personal information from others, such as credit bureaus and affiliates.</p>
<b>Why can't I limit all sharing?</b>	<p>Federal law gives you the right to limit only:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ sharing for affiliates' everyday business purposes – information about your creditworthiness</li> <li>▪ affiliates from using your information to market to you</li> <li>▪ sharing for nonaffiliates to market to you</li> </ul> <p>State laws and individual companies may give you additional rights to limit sharing.</p>
<b>What happens when I limit sharing for an account I hold jointly with someone else?</b>	Your choices will only apply to you. We will share information about the joint accountholder unless the joint accountholder limits our sharing of personal information.

<b>Affiliates</b>	<p>Companies related by common ownership or control. <b>Joint marketing</b>	<p>A formal agreement between nonaffiliated financial companies that together market financial products or services to you.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ As allowed by law The Nationwide Group of Companies may engage in joint marketing agreements to provide you with more financial products and services.</li> </ul>

**California Residents:** We will not share your information with companies (including our affiliates) except as permitted by law, which includes to service your account or with your consent. We will not share information under a joint marketing agreement as defined above without your consent.
